Creating Your Tribute Poster

We will be using google slides to create a one page tribute poster. You will need to log in to your google account, then select the  icon in the upper right hand corner of the page. Find the google slides icon, , and click on it to open a new slide. If a tour page appears, simply exit out of it and it will allow you to start working in google slides.

1. Click on **BLANK** where it says **NEW PRESENTATION**. This will open up a new slide.
2. At that the top left of your screen where it says *Untitled Presentation*, click on it and type **9-11 Tribute**. This is how you name your slide.
3. Next go to **Layout** in your toolbar in the upper middle of the page and click on it and select **BLANK**. You now have a blank slide to create your tribute poster.

Adding IMAGES, TEXT, SHAPES, TABLES, WORDART, or LINES. At the toolbar at the top of the page, select INSERT, a drop down box should appear and then you should select what you would like to insert.

You can add IMAGES easily from the web by going to INSERT, IMAGE, SEARCH THE WEB. This will allow a google panel to open. Type what you want to search for where it says SEARCH FOR GOOGLE IMAGES, then choose a picture. Choose a picture and click on it, then select INSERT at the bottom of the panel. This will insert the image directly into your slide. If you select more than one image it will insert as many as you select.

To resize your image, click on the image and it will highlight the image. Using your mouse cursor, click on a corner of the image and hold down the left mouse button and drag in or out to change the size of your image. To move the image click on it and hold down the cursor and simply move it around the slide to the desired location.

Adding a text box is easy. Choose **INSERT**, then **TEXT BOX**. Next go to your slide and your cursor will look like a large plus sign or crosshair. Left click your mouse and hold down and drag. This will create a text box for you to type into.

Adding WordArt can dress up your poster and make it look more pleasing. To add WordArt, go to **INSERT**, select **WORD ART**, then type what you want to make into WordArt in the box provided and then hit **ENTER** on your keyboard.

9-11 Letter Instruction Sheet

Directions: *You will be writing a letter to someone who was directly affected by 9/11. These people include family members of the victims, first responders, and survivors. It is your job to research the person you are writing so that you can make your letter more personal and ask more meaningful questions.*

Paragraph One In Paragraph one you should include who you are, where you are from, why you are writing this letter, what you hope to learn from it, why you chose this individual, etc. You are not limited to this information and can add anything you think would improve your letter.

Paragraph Two In paragraph two I want you to focus on what you want to know about this person. If the person was a family member of a 9/11 victim, you will probably want to ask questions about them. Try and be as positive and sensitive as you can when discussing a deceased family member, but don't be afraid to ask questions. Ask them how the 9/11 attacks have affected their lives, how they cope with the memories, etc. If you are contacting a survivor or a first responder, you will want to ask questions about how they survived, the conditions that they had to deal with etc. Ask meaningful questions and you will receive a meaningful response from the person you are writing to.

Paragraph Three In paragraph three, you will thank the person for their time and request a response from them. Include your school email address so they can respond to you.
